Directions:

Cuff:

Working with yarn doubled, Cast on 50 (58, 66) Stitches and divide as evenly as possible between needles.

Knit 10 Rounds

Purl 1 round

Knit 10 rounds

Fold cuff under and knit cuff up

Knitting cuff up:

Knit pick up a loop from the cast on edge. Place loop on needle in front of live stitches. K2tog (this knits 1 live stitch together with 1 loop from bottom edge)

Repeat this process until all stitches have been worked.

Knit even around until cuff measures 2 ½" from the fold.

Thumb Gusset:

Right Hand: Knit 25 (29, 33) stitches, pm, M1, K2, M1, pm, Knit to end of round.

Left hand: Knit 23 (27, 31) stitches, pm, M1, K2, M1, pm, Knit to end of round.

Knit 2 rounds

Knit to marker, slip marker, m1, knit to next marker, M1, slip marker, knit to end of round.

Repeat last 3 rounds until there are 16 (20, 24) stitches between the markers

Knit 1 round.

Place all stitches between markers on a stitch holder or waste yarn.

Knit to thumb gap, Cast on 2 stitches, Knit to end of round.

Knit even until glove measures 3 ½ (3 ¾, 4 ¾)" from the beginning of thumb gusset.

Fingers:

Knit around until 6 (7, 8) stitches before end of round.

Place next 12 (14, 16) stitches on a yarn holder or waste yarn

Cast on 2 stitches across the gap and join

Knit even for ¼"

Ring Finger:

Knit 7 (8, 9)

Place 26 (30, 34) stitches on waste yarn

Cast on 2 stitches across the gap, join and knit remaining 7 (8, 9) stitches [16 (18, 20) stitches]

Knit around until finger measures 2 ½ (3, 3 ½)" long

K2tog around

Break yarn and pull tail through remaining stitches. Pull tight

Middle Finger:

Pick up 2 stitches along gap of ring finger, knit 6 (7,8) stitches from waste yarn, cast on 2 stitches across the gap, Knit 6 (7,8) stitches from other end of waste yarn [16 (18, 20) stitches]

Knit around until finger measures 2 ¾ (3 ¼, 3 ¾)" long

K2tog around

Break yarn and pull tail through remaining stitches. Pull tight

Size:

Small (Medium, Large)

Women's S /M (Women's L / Men's S, Men's M / L)

Finished Hand Circumference: 7 (8 ¾, 9 ¾)"

Blocked Gauge:

32 stitches / 44 rows = 4 inches

Materials:

*325 (350, 375) yds Fingering Weight Yarn

*Size 1, 24" or 36" circular needle for magic loop
or Size 1 double pointed needles

*Stitch Markers

*Yarn Needle

Index Finger:

Pick up 2 stitches along gap of middle finger, knit remaining 14 (16, 18) stitches from waste yarn [16 (18,20) stitches]

Knit around until finger measures 2 ¼ (2 ¾, 3 ¼)" long

K2tog around

Break yarn and pull tail through remaining stitches. Pull tight.

Little Finger:

Pick up 4 stitches along ring finger and knit across 10 (12, 14) stitches on waste yarn [14 (16, 18) stitches]

Knit around until finger measures 2 ¼ (2 ¾, 3 ¼)" long

K2tog around

Break yarn and pull tail through remaining stitches. Pull tight

Thumb:

Pick up 4 stitches along thumb gap and knit 16 (20, 24) thumb stitches from stitch holder or waste yarn onto needles and distribute stitches evenly on needles.

SSK, Knit 2, K2tog, Knit to end of round.

Knit thumb even until it measures 2 (2 ½, 2 ½) from the join.

K2tog around.

Break yarn, thread through remaining stitches, and pull tight.

Weave in all ends.

Repeat for second Glove

NOTE: Be sure that you knit 1 RIGHT glove and 1 LEFT glove. Gloves don't work as well if you have 2 of the same kind.
