

Lace Leaf Bookmark – Crochet Pattern by Sarah Gross



Materials: (may contain affiliate links, view affiliate disclosure [here](#))

Size E (3.5mm) crochet hook

DK Weight Yarn #3 (Twice Sheared Sheep Colorstory DK) approximately 26 yds

[Stitch Markers](#)

Scissors and Needle for weaving in ends

Gauge:

5.5 sts in DC = 1 inch

Check your gauge and adjust hook size accordingly.

Notes:

- This pattern is worked in rows
- Blocking is highly recommended
- As always, feel free to email me with any questions about this pattern.
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Abbreviations (US terms):

Sl St – Slip Stitch

CH – Chain

CH SP – Chain Space

SC – Single Crochet

DC – Double Crochet

Dc2tog – Double Crochet 2 together (decrease)

Dc3tog – Double Crochet 3 together (decrease)

St(s) – Stitch(es)

Instructions:

Ch 19

1. DC in 3rd ch (2 skipped ch do NOT count as a st). ch 4, sk 5 ch, 3DC in next ch. Ch 3, sk 3 ch, 3DC in next ch. Ch 4, sk 5 ch, DC in last ch. Turn.
2. Ch 3 (counts as DC, or use Stacked SC method), ch 2, sk ch sp, 2DC in next st, DC in next st, 2DC in next st. Ch 2, DC in ch 3 sp. Ch 2, 2DC in next st, DC in next st, 2DC in next st. Ch 2, sk ch sp, DC in last st. Turn.
3. Ch 3 (counts as DC, or Stacked SC), ch 2, sk ch sp, dc2tog, DC, dc2tog. Ch 3, sk ch sp, 3DC in next st, ch 3, sk ch sp, dc2tog, DC, dc2tog. Ch 2, sk ch sp, DC in last st. Turn.
4. Ch 3 (counts as DC, or Stacked SC), ch 1, sk ch sp, dc3tog, ch 3, sk ch sp, DC in next st. Ch 3, sk 1 st, DC in next st. Ch 3, sk ch sp, dc3tog, ch 1, DC in last st. Turn.
5. Ch 3 (counts as DC, or Stacked SC), ch 4, sk 5 st/ch, 3DC in next ch. Ch 3, sk 3 ch, 3DC in next ch. Ch 4, sk 5 st/ch, DC in last ch. Turn.

Repeat rows 2-5 until you reach 1.5 inches shorter than desired total length, ending with a row 3. Then continue to decrease section below.

Decreases

1. Ch 3 (counts as DC, or Stacked SC), ch 1, sk ch sp, dc3tog, ch 3, sk ch sp, 2DC in next st, DC in next st, 2DC in next st. Ch 3, sk ch sp, dc3tog, ch 1, DC in last st. Turn.
2. Ch 3 (counts as DC, or Stacked SC), ch 4, sk 5 st/ch, dc2tog, DC, dc2tog. Ch 4, sk 5 st/ch, DC in last ch. Turn.
3. Ch 3 (counts as DC, or Stacked SC), ch 2, sk ch sp, dc3tog, ch 2, sk ch sp, DC in last st.

FINISHING

Cut yarn, weave in ends.

Block your bookmark. I blocked mine to measure approximately 8.5 inches tall x 3.5 inches wide.
