

## Mermaid Iced Cup Cozy – Crochet Pattern by Sarah Gross



**Size:** Fits a 20 oz cup

**Materials:** (may contain affiliate links, view affiliate disclosure [here](#))

Size F (3.75mm) crochet hook

DK Weight Yarn #3 ([TSS Colorstory DK](#)) in 4 colors:

MC – approximately 35 yds

CC1 – approximately 12 yds

CC2 – approximately 12 yds

CC3 – approximately 12 yds

[Stitch Markers](#)

Scissors and Needle for weaving in ends

**Gauge:**

5 sts (hdc), 3.5 rows = 1 inch

**Abbreviations (US terms):**

Sl St – Slip Stitch

CH – Chain

CH SP – Chain Space

SK – Skip

BLO – Back loop only

SC – Single Crochet

HDC – Half Double Crochet

DC – Double Crochet

St(s) – Stitch(es)

**Notes:**

- Crocheted in the round.
- Beginning Ch 1 does NOT count as a st, unless otherwise indicated.
- Keep MC attached the whole project. Cut the CC colors in between uses.
- 7dc in same st = Shell st.
- Instructions are for a 20 oz cup.

**Instructions:**

With MC, make a magic circle

1. Ch 1, 10 hdc in magic circle, pull tight to close, sl st to first hdc to join.
2. Ch 1, 2hdc in ea st around. Join. 20 sts
3. Ch 1, hdc in first st, 2hdc in the next st. \*Hdc in the next st, 2hdc in the next st.\* Repeat around. Join. 30 sts
4. Ch 1, hdc in first 4 sts, 2hdc in the next st. \*Hdc in the next 4 sts, 2hdc in the next st.\* Repeat around. Join. 36 sts
5. Ch 1, hdc in ea st around.
6. Repeat round 5
7. Ch 1, hdc in first 5 sts, 2hdc in the next st. \*Hdc in the next 5 sts, 2hdc in the next st.\* Repeat around. Join. 42 sts

Add CC1

8. With CC1 - Ch 1, 7dc in same st as join. \*Sk next 2 sts, sc in next st. Sk 2 sts, 7dc in next st.\* Repeat around to last 5 sts. Sk 2 sts, sc in next st. Sk 2 sts, sl st to first st to join.
9. With MC - Join to sl st from previous round. Ch 4 (counts as dc and ch 1), dc in same st as join. \*Ch 5, sk 7 sts, in next st (dc, ch 1, dc).\* Repeat around to last shell. Ch 5, sl st to 3rd ch of beginning ch 4.

Add CC2

10. With CC2 - Ch 1, 7dc in ch 1 sp. \*Sc in 4th dc of shell st below (make sure to capture the ch 5 from previous round). 7dc in next ch 1 sp.\* Repeat around to last shell st. Sc in 4th dc of shell st below (capturing ch 5 from previous round). Sl st to first st to join.
11. Repeat round 9 with MC

Add CC3

12. With CC3 - Ch 1, 7dc in ch 1 sp. \*Sc in 4th dc of shell st below (make sure to capture the ch 5 from previous round). 7dc in next ch 1 sp.\* Repeat around to last shell st. Sc in 4th dc of shell st below (capturing ch 5 from previous round). Sl st to first st to join.
13. Repeat round 9 with MC

Repeat rounds 8-12 one more time.

Cut all CC colors and continue only with MC

19.Ch 2 (does NOT count as st), dc blo in same st as join. \*Hdc blo in the next 2 sts, sc blo in the next st, hdc blo in the next 2 sts, dc blo in the next 3 sts\*  
Repeat around, ending with dc in the last 2 sts. Join to first st.

20.Ch 1, hdc blo around. Join.

### **FINISHING**
