

Mermaid Iced Cup Cozy – Knitting Pattern by Sarah Gross



Size: Fits a 20 oz cup.

Materials: (may contain affiliate links, view affiliate disclosure [here](#))

Size 4 (3.5 mm) needles, long circular for magic loop, or dpns

Size 5 (3.75 mm) needles, long circular for magic loop, or dpns

DK Weight Yarn #3 ([TSS Colorstory DK](#)) in 4 colors:

MC – approximately 37 yds

CC1 – approximately 10 yds

CC2 – approximately 7 yds

CC3 – approximately 10 yds

[Stitch Markers](#)

[Row Counter](#)

Scissors and Needle for weaving in ends

Gauge:

6 sts, 8.5 rows in stockinette = 1 inch (Blocked, using size 5 needles)

Check your gauge and adjust needle size accordingly.

Abbreviations:

CO – Cast on

K – Knit

P – Purl

St(s) – Stitch(es)

DPN – Double pointed needle

Notes:

- Use the disappearing loop cast on, or alternatively cast on the appropriate number of stitches and sew hole closed.
- Use DPNs or the magic loop method.
- This is knit in the round. Use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of the round.
- Repeat sections will be noted with * *
- Instructions are for a 20 oz cup.

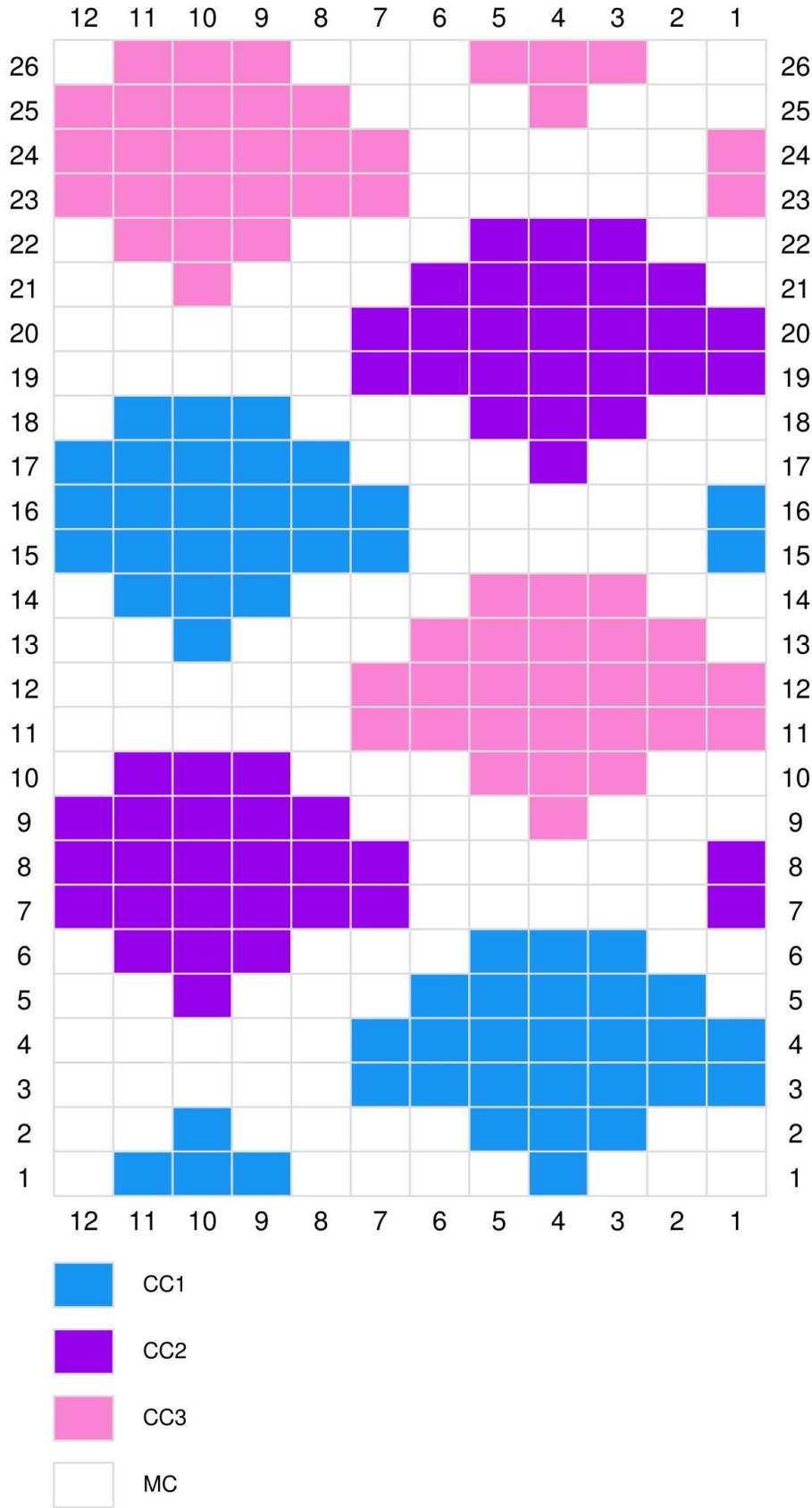
Instructions:

Using MC, size 5 needles, and disappearing loop method, CO 10 sts. Join to work in the round.

1. Kfb around. (20 sts)
2. K around
3. *K1, kfb* Repeat around. (30 sts)
4. K around
5. *K2, kfb* Repeat around. (40 sts)
6. K around
7. *K3, kfb* Repeat around. (50 sts)
8. K around
9. K around
10. K around
11. *K4, kfb* Repeat around. (60 sts)
12. K around

Add CC1 and work color chart below. Or use row-by-row instructions below the chart.

Row-by-Row Instructions (repeat around)

1. (MC) x 3, (CC1) x 1, (MC) x 4, (CC1) x 3, (MC) x 1
2. (MC) x 2, (CC1) x 3, (MC) x 4, (CC1) x 1, (MC) x 2
3. (CC1) x 7, (MC) x 5
4. (CC1) x 7, (MC) x 5
5. (MC) x 1, (CC1) x 5, (MC) x 3, (CC2) x 1, (MC) x 2
6. (MC) x 2, (CC1) x 3, (MC) x 3, (CC2) x 3, (MC) x 1
7. (CC2) x 1, (MC) x 5, (CC2) x 6
8. (CC2) x 1, (MC) x 5, (CC2) x 6
9. (MC) x 3, (CC3) x 1, (MC) x 3, (CC2) x 5
10. (MC) x 2, (CC3) x 3, (MC) x 3, (CC2) x 3, (MC) x 1
11. (CC3) x 7, (MC) x 5
12. (CC3) x 7, (MC) x 5
13. (MC) x 1, (CC3) x 5, (MC) x 3, (CC1) x 1, (MC) x 2
14. (MC) x 2, (CC3) x 3, (MC) x 3, (CC1) x 3, (MC) x 1
15. (CC1) x 1, (MC) x 5, (CC1) x 6
16. (CC1) x 1, (MC) x 5, (CC1) x 6
17. (MC) x 3, (CC2) x 1, (MC) x 3, (CC1) x 5
18. (MC) x 2, (CC2) x 3, (MC) x 3, (CC1) x 3, (MC) x 1
19. (CC2) x 7, (MC) x 5
20. (CC2) x 7, (MC) x 5
21. (MC) x 1, (CC2) x 5, (MC) x 3, (CC3) x 1, (MC) x 2
22. (MC) x 2, (CC2) x 3, (MC) x 3, (CC3) x 3, (MC) x 1
23. (CC3) x 1, (MC) x 5, (CC3) x 6
24. (CC3) x 1, (MC) x 5, (CC3) x 6
25. (MC) x 3, (CC3) x 1, (MC) x 3, (CC3) x 5
26. (MC) x 2, (CC3) x 3, (MC) x 3, (CC3) x 3, (MC) x 1

After completing colorwork chart, cut all CC colors, and continue with MC only below.

1. K around
2. K around
3. K around

Switch to size 4 needles

4. P around
5. K around
6. P around

Bind off loosely knitwise.

FINISHING

Cut yarn and weave in any remaining ends.

I highly recommend blocking your cozy to really make the fair isle design pop.
