

Treasure Hunt Cowl – Crochet Pattern by Sarah Gross



Materials:

Size I (5.5mm) crochet hook

DK Weight Yarn #3 (TSS Colorstory DK) in 3 colors:

Color 1 – approximately 121 yds

Color 2 – approximately 90 yds

Color 3 – approximately 90 yds

Beading Needle

Size 6/0 beads

Stitch Markers

Scissors and Needle for weaving in ends

Gauge:

4.5 sts (sc) = 1 inch (Blocked)

Abbreviations (US terms):

Sl St – Slip Stitch

CH – Chain

CH SP – Chain Space

SK – Skip

BLO – Back loop only

FLO – Front loop only

SC – Single Crochet

SCw/bead - Single Crochet with a bead

HDC – Half Double Crochet

DC – Double Crochet

TRC – Treble Crochet

St(s) – Stitch(es)

RS – Right Side

WS – Wrong Side

Notes:

- Crocheted in the round.
- Beginning Ch 1 does NOT count as a st, unless otherwise indicated.

Instructions:

Strand 28 beads for each color block.

Ch 112. Join with sl st to first ch, being careful not to twist.

1. (WS) Working in the back bump of the beginning chain, SC in the first 3 sts. SCw/bead in the next st. *SC in the next 3 sts, SCw/bead in the next st.* Repeat around. Join with sl st to first SC. TURN.
2. (RS) Ch 1, SC blo in ea st around. Join.
3. (RS) Ch 1, SC in the first st. “Ch 1, sk next st. HDC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, DC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, TRC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, TRC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, DC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, HDC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, SC in the next 3 sts.* Repeat around, ending with 2 SC. Join.
4. (RS) Ch 1, SC in ea st and ch sp around. Join.

Strand 28 beads onto color 2 and join color 2 in same st as join, TURN, and continue with only that color.

5. (WS) Ch 1, working FLO this round, SC in the same st as join and the next 2 sts. SCw/bead in the next st. *SC in the next 3 sts, SCw/bead in the next st.* Repeat around. Join with sl st to first SC. TURN.
6. (RS) Ch 1, SC blo in ea st around. Join.

7. (RS) Ch 1, sk first st, DC in the next st. Ch 1, sk next st, HDC in next st.
Ch 1, sk next st, SC in the next 3 sts. Ch 1, sk next st. HDC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, DC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, TRC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, TRC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, DC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, HDC in next st. Repeat around. End with a TRC in the last st. Ch 1, sk first st from round, join with sl st to first DC.
8. (RS) Ch 1, sc in the ch sp from the end of the previous round (this is now your starting stitch of the round). SC in ea st and ch sp around. Join.

Strand 28 beads onto color 3 and join color 3 in same st as join, TURN, and continue with only that color.

9. (WS) Ch 1, SC in the same st as join, and the next 2 sts. SCw/bead in the next st. *SC in the next 3 sts, SCw/bead in the next st.* Repeat around. Join with sl st to first SC. TURN.
- 10.(RS) Ch 1, SC blo in ea st around. Join.
- 11.(RS) Ch 1, SC in the first st. “Ch 1, sk next st. HDC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, DC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, TRC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, TRC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, DC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, HDC in next st, Ch 1, sk next st, SC in the next 3 sts.* Repeat around, ending with 2 SC. Join.
- 12.(RS) Ch 1, SC in ea st and ch sp around. Join.

Continue below:

Color 1 – Repeat rounds 5-8
Color 2 – Repeat rounds 9-12
Color 3 – Repeat rounds 5-8
Color 1 – Repeat rounds 9-12
Color 2 – Repeat rounds 5-8
Color 3 – Repeat rounds 9-12
Color 1 – Strand 56 beads this time, Repeat rounds 5-8

Continue with final round below, or continue with established pattern above for a taller cowl.

Final round, continue with color 1:

- **TURN.** (WS) Ch 1, SC in the same st as join, and the next 2 sts. SCw/bead in the next st. *SC in the next 3 sts, SCw/bead in the next st.* Repeat around. Join with sl st to first SC.

FINISHING

Cut yarn and weave in any remaining ends. I highly recommend blocking your cowl so the lace pattern really pops.
